NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A MEETING OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE ABOVE-NAMED CITY WILL BE HELD ON THE 14TH DAY OF OCTOBER 2022 AT 6:00 PM IN THE KENEFICK CIVIC CENTER AT 228 FM 2797 IN KENEFICK TEXAS, AT WHICH TIME, THE FOLLOWING SUBJECTS WILL BE DISCUSSED TO-WIT:

1: CALL TO ORDER.

2: CITIZEN PARTICIPATION-CITIZEN COMMENT PERIOD.

ALL PERSONS WISHING TO ADDRESS THE GOVERNING BODY UNDER THIS AGENDA SHALL SIGN IN BEFORE THE MEETING WITH THE CITY SECRETARY AND SHALL BE LIMITED TO A 3 MINUTE PRESENTATION. THE GOVERNING BODY MAY ONLY MAKE A STATEMENT OF SPECIFIC FACTUAL INFORMATION GIVEN IN RESPONSE TO AN INQUARY, RECITATION OF EXISTING POLICY IN RESPONSE TO AN INQUARY: OR DELIBERATE OR DECIDE ABOUT THE SUBJECT OF AN INQUARY ONLY REGARDING A PROPOSSAL TO PLACE THE SUBJECT ON THE AGENDA FOR A SUBSEQUENT MEETING.

3: EXECUTIVE SESSION: A CLOSED MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL WILL BE HELD FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- A. TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, SECTION 551.072. DELIBERATION REGARDING REAL PROPERTY: THE CITY COUNCIL WILL CONDUCT A CLOSED MEETING TO DELIBERATE THE PURCHASE, EXCHANGE, LEASE, OR VALUE OF REAL PROPERTY AS DELIBERATION IN AN OPEN MEETING WOULD HAVE A DETRIMENTAL EFFECT ON THE POSITION OF THE CITY IN NEGOTIATIONS WITH A THIRD PERSON.
- B. TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 551.071. CONSULTATION WITH ATTORNEY; CLOSED MEETING. THE CITY COUNCIL WILL CONDUCT A PRIVATE CONSULTATION WITH ITS ATTORNEY:(1) WHEN THE GOVERNMENTAL BODY SEEKS THE ADVICE OF ITS ATTORNEY ABOUT:(A) PENDING OR CONTEMPLATED LITIGATION; OR (B) A SETTLEMENT OFFER; OR (2) ON A MATTER IN WHICH THE DUTY OF THE ATTORNEY TO THE GOVERNMENTAL BODY UNDER THE TEXAS DISCIPLINARY RULES OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT OF THE STATE BAR OF TEXAS CLEARLY CONFLICTS WITH CHAPTER 551 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE.

4: RECONVENE INTO REGULAR SESSION AND CONSIDER ACTION, IF ANY, ON ITEMS DISCUSSED IN EXECUTIVE SESSION.

5. REQUESTS FOR FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS, COMMENTS, AND ANNOUNCEMENTS.

6. ADJOURN.

The city council reserves the right to adjourn into executive session at any time during this meeting to discuss any of the matters listed above, as authorized by Texas Government Code Section 551.071 (Consultation with Attorney), 551.072 (Deliberations about Real Property), 551.073 (Deliberations about Gifts and Donations), 551.074 (Personnel Matters), 551.076 (Deliberations about Security Devices), and 551.087 (Economic Development).
